

## The History of Nakano Shrine & Nakano-Momiji-yama

It is said that Nakano shrine was built in 795 by Tamuramaro Sakanoue; a naval officer while he was going around "Ezo (Northern japan)" to suppress the area. The enshrined deity is Yamato Takeru no Mikoto (a hero in ancient Japan).

The history of maple trees around the shrine dates back to 1802 when the 9th lord of Hirosaki clan, Yasuchika Tsugaru stayed in Nuruyu area.

During his stay, he was deeply impressed by beauty of Fudo fall and decided to collect over 100varieties of young maple plants from Kyoto. He then dedicated the plants to the shrine, and the next year, three maple trees were planted.

As they grew, the mountain became famous as a scenic spot for maple trees. Just like Arashiyama area in Kyoto, which is famous for breathtaking view of fall colors, Nakano-Momiji-yama became famous as a "Little Arashiyama" attracting many visitors. Back in 1983, the 3 maple trees were assigned as Kuroishi City's natural monuments. Besides them, two fir trees over 200 years old were assigned as natural treasures of Aomori Prefecture. With Kokujyoji temple in Hirakawa City (former Ikarigaseki-village) and Nagaizawa shrine in Kuroishi City, Nakano shrine is known as "Three major Fudo (one of the Five Wisdom Kings in Buddhism)" in the Tsugaru region.












## ap for Nakano-Momiji-yama は 東北の小嵐山「中野もみじ山」 散策マップ

D. The popular photo spot; "Fudo Falls".




B. Another picture perfect spot: "Kanpudai(open square)"
